The Pasadena Business Association offers scholarships to selected high school seniors who attend either Northeast or Chesapeake High Schools, or live in the attendance area for these schools but attend the AACPS Virtual Academy or another public or private school. Applications must be completed and returned to the school Guidance Department by April 22, 2024 or mailed to the PBA Office at P.O. Box 861, Pasadena, Maryland 21123-0861. Applications sent by mail must be postmarked no later than April 22, 2024 The Guidance Counselors have until the end of business on April 23, 2024 to deliver the applications to Arundel Federal Savings Bank, 4179 Mountain Road Road, Lake Shore Plaza who will deliver them to the PBA Office. The applications may be dropped off at the drive through window also. Applications received after these dates will not be processed.

Applicants may use the attached application. An electronic application can be found on the PasadenaBusinessAssociation.com or emailing PasadenaBusinessAssociation1@verizon.net, or on Naviance found on the school website. The application package must include a high school transcript and the completed application with the essay. It is optional, but acceptable to include other artifacts and documentation such as a letter of recommendation, articles or copy of SAT scores.

Scholarships will be announced at the awards night held at the school. Scholarship recipients will be honored at a PBA general membership luncheon meeting on **June 5**, **2024** at 12 o'clock at Kurtz's Beach. We will send letters to the scholarship recipients in May if they are awarded a scholarship. Parents, grandparents, etc. will be able to attend this luncheon at a cost of \$22 each with a reservation. Please note that only recipients will be notified. We are not able to send letters to all applicants.

The PBA Scholarship Fundraiser will be held on April 1st at a Quarter Auction at Earleigh Heights Fire hall. Check our website for more details or contact Melissa Hosse, 443-570-8098.
